This pro bono position involves (a) administering the internship, including managing the APPIC Match process, maintaining policy documents and promoting the site, and (b) providing “supervision of supervision” for 2 pre-doctoral interns per year. Under supervision of a Licensed Psychologist, this part-time residency consists of providing individual and group counselling for university students presenting with a wide range of difficulties, including mental health, career-related, and academic. **PhD Student Advisor**, Educational and Counselling Psychology, and Special Education, University of British Columbia. Duties include providing information, guidance and support for PhD-level graduate students encountering difficulties with some aspects of their program of study, and representing PhD students’ interests at departmental meetings. (2003 – 2004)

**Mental Health Clinician**, Ministry for Children and Family Development, Delta Child and Youth Mental Health Team. Clinical duties include individual, group and family therapy for youth presenting with a range of mental health issues. Other duties included integrated case management, assessment, and consultation with other therapists on the team. (1999 – 2001)

**Mental Health Clinician** (auxiliary), Ministry for Children and Family Development, Abbotsford Child and Youth Mental Health Team. Duties include suicide response and individual and group therapy for children and youth presenting with a range of mental health issues. Other duties included integrated case management, case consultation, and participation in early intervention activities within the community. (1998 – 1999)
