Doctoral Programs

Doctor of Education

This blended (face-to-face and online delivery) program is designed to accommodate working professionals and students who reside in or outside Calgary. Students have up to six years to complete all degree requirements. The first three years of the program include course work.

PhD in Educational Research

The PhD program in Educational Research allows students to explore and develop expertise in a specialization. Our program is full-time with a residency (on campus) component. Students study the following specialization areas: Adult Learning, Curriculum & Learning, Language & Literacy, Leadership, or Learning Sciences.


PhD in Counselling Psychology
